Receiving Christ

John 1:12-"But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name:"

So many people say that you become a child of God when you "receive Christ." They usually this is praying the sinner's prayer. But what does "receiving Christ" here mean? This passage says that those who received Christ (who are then identified as believers in Jesus) were then given the power or right to become children of God. You cannot become what you already are! Believers are not children of God: they have the power to become children of God. The Bible teaches we are made children of God when we as believers repent of our sins and are baptized into Him.

Galatians 3:26-27-"For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. 27 For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ."
